PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bob Pyle turned in receipts after picking up the lawnmower from repairs. Total repairs totaled \$168.77

SECRETARY REPORT:

Minutes were presented to each member and read. A Motion to accept the minutes as written was made by Cathie Kisser, Starla Jordan and seconded by Starla Jordan. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

The Treasurer's report was given to each member. Motion made by Cathie Kisser to accept the Treasurer's report and seconded by Starla Jordan. Motion carried. Motion to pay all bills was made by David Yahr and seconded by Cathie Kisser. Roll Call: Starla-Yes, David-Yes, Cathie-Yes, Terry-Yes. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Portable Sign:

- New portable sign has not been purchased. Terry will keep the committee updated on the status.

Painting of Pavilion A:

- Complete Coating will paint Pavilion A for \$3358. Terry will present before the board at the next township meeting. T-111 siding will be inspected to see if it can be repaired or replaced before the Pavilion is painted.

Walking Trail Repairs:

- Yeager submitted a bid for \$1200 to repair the cracks in the walking trail. David made a motion to accept the bid and have them repair the track, Cathie

seconded, motion carried. Terry will present before the board at the next township meeting.

Plumbing:

- There were no leaks in the bathrooms at this time. Bob Pyle will keep an eye on the plumbing and let the committee know if there are any issues.

Picnic Tables in Pavilion A:

- David made a motion for \$500.00 in materials to redo the picnic tables in Pavilion A. Motion seconded by Starla, motion carried. Terry will present before the board at the next township meeting.

Grants:

- The \$8000 matching grant from Midland Area Community Foundation for handicap parking at the pavilions has been placed in the park account.
- Three other grants have been written to help with the matching grant. The committee will be breaking down the handicap parking and sidewalk in stages as the money becomes available.

New Business:

New Committee Members:

- New committee members were sworn in before meeting. Cathie accepted the position as Vice Chairman.

Refund:

- Park received a refund from the township water project in the amount of \$6556.00.

Park Rules:

- Park rules were presented and discussed to the committee for Pavilion usage. After a few corrections, Terry made a motion to accept the park rules, Starla seconded. Motion carried. A copy of the rules will be sent along with the reservation slip to individuals reserving the Pavilions.

Laptop for Treasurer:

- Starla proposed getting a laptop use in grant and treasury reports. She found some refurbished laptops for under \$200.00. David made a motion for Starla to get a laptop under \$200, Cathie seconded. Motion carried.

Park Picnic:

- This year's park picnic will be July 18, 2015. Suggestions or ideas can be presented to any committee member.

Motion to adjourn was made by David and seconded by Starla at 8:10p.m. Motion carried.

Hope Township Woodside Park Rules and General Guidance

Listed below are Park rules and general guidelines for the use of the Pavilions.

1. No serving and/or consuming of alcoholic beverages at the park at any time.
2. No driving on grass. Use designated parking areas only. Only exception is parking area near entrance of park.
3. There is a \$25.00 fee for non-Hope residents.
4. Decorations are permitted. Use tacks/staples only, no screws or nails. Please remove all decorations/tacks/staples before departure.
5. Individual making the reservation is responsible for ensuring Pavilion is clean upon departure. Dispose of all trash in the dumpster behind Pavilion B. If there is a problem with the Pavilion, please contact a Committee member.
6. Hope Township is not responsible for loss and/or damage to personal property.
7. Do not remove tables from other Pavilion or park grounds without consent from Park Committee.
8. Park offers 2 horse shoe pits, volleyball, 4 baseball diamonds, ½ basketball court, walking trail, 11 picnic tables in each pavilion, electrical outlets in each pavilion, several grills throughout the park, and indoor restrooms with city water.
9. There are games and equipment available for use in the side door of the concession stand (west side). Please return all equipment back to the room when done using it.
