

Hope Township Road Committee

The Hope township road committee was called to order on January 6th 2018 at 7 pm by Jody Jordan, chairperson of the committee.

Board members present Jody Jordan, Doug Schoffner, Bob Davis, David Yahr and Robert Kelley.

The meeting was started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken and all board members were present.

The first order of business was to accept a petition presented by Robert Blazejewski of Thomas Shores subdivision. Mr. Blazejewski stated that the roads in the subdivision are in need of replacement. The condition of the Roads (Richmond Dr. and Grace Ct. have worsened since the installation of the Hope Township water system Chairperson Jody Jordan accepted the petition from Mr. Blazejewski.

After the board members read the meeting minutes of February 2 2017, Chairperson Jordan made a motion to approve the meeting minutes

Bob Davis seconded the motion and a vote was taken. The vote was 5 yes and 0 no's.

The Chairperson then opened the floor up for discussion on what course would be taken on road improvements this year.

The township has 160,508.53 dollars for road improvement this year. The 2018 allocation is as follows

Matching funds	\$35,451.06
Non matching	\$33,481.55
Hope Millage	\$91,575.92
Total funding	\$160,508.53

Discussion began on the priorities for 2018 and after some discussion the consensus was

1. Prep Adams road for paving in 2019 from M-30 to 5 Mile. This consists of Drainage, upgrade, storm drains and new gravel and shape. This would cost \$66,962.40

Motion was made by Bob Davis to prep Adams for paving in 2019. David Yahr seconded the motion and a vote was taken.

5 yes and 0 no's

2. Gravel and reshape Stark road from Saiko to Dead-end which would be .44 miles. With a cost of \$16,828.94

A motion was made by Bob Davis and seconded by Doug Schoffner. A vote was taken.

5 yes and 0 no's.

3. Gravel and reshape North 5 mile from Saiko south for ½ mile with a cost of \$24,202.00
Motion made by David Yahr and seconded by Bob Davis.

A vote was taken 5 yes and 0 no's

4. Gravel and reshape East Saiko from Middle East to Stark 1 mile with a cost of \$29,456.12.
This was discussed when the power went out to be included in the 2018 work. Discussed at the meeting during the power outage and approved at the Township Board meeting on Tuesday February 13, 2018.

A vote was taken 5 yes and 0 no's.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Jody Jordan and seconded by Bob Davis. Meeting was Adjourned at 7 50 pm.
