

## Hope Township Road Committee

The Hope township road committee meeting was called to order on October 30<sup>th</sup> 2018 at 7 pm by Jody Jordan chairperson of the committee.

The meeting was started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken and the following board members were present, Jody Jordan, Doug Schoffner, David Yahr. Bob Davis was unable to attend the meeting.

There was no public comment.

The next order of business was to read & accept the meeting minutes of February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018 The motion to accept was made by Jody Jordon and 2<sup>nd</sup> David Yahr

The next order of business was a review of work completed in 2018.

There was discussion by the committee on the lack of work being done on Saiko rd from Middle rd to Stark and Stark rd from Saiko to the dead end and the prepping of Adams rd for resurfacing next year. The Midland county road commission assured Andy Kobisa, Supv. For Hope Township that this work would be done by November of this year

The bids for 2019 were looked at with the following roads listed to be worked on.

Adams rd.	Paving	\$87,185.25
Richmond Drive	Crown, Wedge and fog coat	\$50,257.20
Grace Court	Crown, Wedge and fog coat.	\$17,566.15

Robert Kelley has concerns about the Crown Wedging process proposed for Richmond Drive and Grace Ct. and requested a bid for repaving Richmond Dr. and Grace Ct. Andy said that he would get bids for the above mention road.

At this time until we get more info on the re paving cost for Richmond Dr. and Grace Ct. no action will be taken until repaving bids can be evaluated and another meeting can be scheduled to address this issue

Dublin rd between Hull rd. and Baker , Hicks rd. between Shaffer rd and Bombay rd and Hull rd between 5 mile and M-30 have been added to the 5 year evaluation plan.

A Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Jody Jordon and seconded by David Yahr. The meeting was adjourned at 8 10pm.
