

Woodside Park Commission Meeting of 05.07.2019

Call to order at 1900 with the pledge to the Flag at the park, pavilion B.

There was no public for comment

All Commissioners were present, in addition to Steve & Jill.

Actual dedication of the park including Pavilion B and the “all-purpose building” took place in May of 1992. So this year is not the 30th anniversary of the opening of the park. That will be in 2022. So we have lots of time to track folks down who were involved in the origination of Woodside Park.

Projects for 2019 (recommendations)

Finish the old bathrooms – this will involve painting, installing vents, etc.

Modify the grill – actually, this has been done, David picked up a piece of steel and Doug will take care of welding it to the grate.

Fixing the holes in the cement in Pavilion B – done.

Benches – these are the ones along the walking path – we will be making new ones and replacing the ones out there now. We also will be putting routings on these benches in honor of past commissioners/custodians who have passed and were veterans. i.e. Terry Chrivia, Larry Maxwell and Jimmy Wieske.

New Business

Work day – this has been set for June 15th at 9 a.m. Anyone who is able is welcome to come on out and help us get ready for the picnic.

There was no other business.
