

Hope Township Road Committee 2021 Feb

February 11, 2021 7pm

Meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken: Jody, Bob D, Robert K

In person attendees waited a few minutes to allow others, if any, to join via zoom

* Minutes from November 19th, 2019 were read and accepted. (Due to Michigan mandates, meetings were not held in 2020 for Road Committee) A motion to approve was made by Bob David and was seconded by Robert Kelley.

* Members reviewed the proposed 2020 Road Improvements for Grace Court and Richmond Drive. Those improvements were not completed in 2020 due to the spring Flood and Dam break disaster. The Midland Road Commission instead repaired essential Roads in the county which were damaged by the Dam Failure and flood damage. Drainage issues on Grace Court are now addressed and preparation work by the County Drain commission for Bombay Road is also ready for paving this year, 2021.

* The allocation and Budget for Road work projects in 2021 were presented by Jody along with estimates of cost from the County Road Commission. . Saiko Road, between Meridian Rd and Five Mile Rd, was added to the list of improvements needed. A motion was made to improve drainage on Saiko Rd by Jody and seconded by Robert Kelley. Roll call was taken and all agreed. The coming year, 2021, will be very busy for road improvements. There are 2 projects not completed in 2020 and they will carry-over.

* Estimates costs for Road Improvements for 2021 are:

* There was discussion about 2 projects, Hicks Rd and Baker Rd, for the 2022 Road improvement agenda.

* October 21, 2020 was selected for our next meeting date.

* Jody asked for a motion to end the meeting. David Yahr motioned to end the meeting and Bob Davis Seconded.
