Meeting called to order at the Park – Pavilion B with the pledge of allegiance at 1900 hours

New Business –

- The pine tree in the turnaround was planted to celebrate the 40<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary and retirement of Bob & Pat Holzhausen. As it is a challenge to mow around and 2020 marks Bob and Pat's 65<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary, Cathie is going to get with siblings and grand kids to take that tree out and fund the building of a gazebo. This was well received by fellow commissioners with the addition of making lumber from the tree to at least make a plaque to mark the gazebo.

Other Business –

- Due to excessive theft of water – we will only be turning on the outside spigot when the pavilions are rented.
- We will also be adding to the newsletter with the summer tax bills that beginning 2021 there will be a \$25 rental fee for all pavilion rentals with a list of requirements to be met for township residents only to have that fee forgiven.
- As per the new budget – commissioners will receive a 2% increase in pay. Steve will have his 3% raise we gave him last year (after budget) begin July 2020. We also decided to give both Steve & Jill a bonus later in the year.
