

Woodside Park Commission Meeting of October 6, 2020

Meeting called to order by Chairperson David at 1900 with the pledge to the flag.

Commissioner Starla was absent today but had sent us a treasurer's report. In addition to our other four commissioners, our fantastic caretakers Steve & Jill were also present.

There was no public for comment.

There was a moment to review the minutes to our last meeting – Jared moved to accept, seconded by David to approve minutes.

We were given a moment to look over the treasurer's report that David had printed. Motion was made by Cathie to accept, seconded by David. Report will be filed.

Motion made by Cathie, seconded by Doug to pay bills. Roll call – David – Yes, Doug – Yes, Jared – Yes, Cathie – Yes. Bills will be submitted for payment.

Old business and new business sort of combined here. All had to do with park reservations. Secretary read what had been a mock up of what we wanted to do. That will be attached to this report. In essence – if a person from outside the township reserves a pavilion, there is a fee of \$25 plus a deposit of \$25. If the pavilion is restored post event, the deposit will be returned or shredded, per request. If a person who resides in the township reserves a pavilion, a deposit of \$25 is required. Again, if pavilion is restored post event, deposit is returned or shredded.

Other business –

Trunk N Treat – not sure how that is going to work this year. Starla plans on purchasing candy for commissioners to hand out in bags (which she will also purchase). As everything needs to be pre-packaged, we will not be doing the 2 dozen cookies as in years past.

Our treasurer states we should have enough to get a load of gravel to fill in pot holes and low spots in the turn around. Steve will contact Coggins. Therefore we will need a work day for a tractor with loader to be here to assist in that endeavor.

Steve and Jill tell us they have put signs on the trash bins asking folks to “Please throw trash bags in the dumpster” and this seems to be working.

That was all there was to discuss. Doug made motion to adjourn, seconded by Cathie.
