

Woodside Park Commission Meeting of Tuesday, April 6, 2021

Meeting called to order at 1903 (David was running late)

Pledge to the flag with five commissioners present with Darlene via Zoom – all present along with caretakers Jill and Steve. We also had another couple join us this evening, Rob and Anita – more on that later.

Review of minutes from 03.02.2021 –there were two corrections. Darlene joined on Zoom, not skype. Also, concerning the Santa parade – whoever runs the parade plows the driveway, not the park commission. Otherwise with changes Starla made motion to approve, seconded by Doug with all ayes.

Review of treasurer's report – Starla also presented a tentative budget for the 2021-2022 fiscal year to present to the township board. Cathie made motion to approve, seconded by David – all ayes.

Pay Bill Authorization – Cathie made motion to pay bills, seconded by Doug with roll call – David – yes, Doug – yes, Starla – yes, Darlene = yes, Cathie – yes. Bills will be submitted for payment.

Old Business –

Annual Picnic – we have elected to delay planning at least until next month as many events are still being cancelled because of Covid. It is not something we are able to enforce social distancing and serving food, etc.

Projects – we will need to look into putting metal roofs on the barn and pavilion A. We also need to check into gutters for the restroom/office building. Seamless appears to be best, that will be checked into.

Opening the park – this year that will be on Monday April 19, 2021. The outside faucet is off the building now and probably won't go back on as it has been repeatedly abused and broken.

New Business –

Disk golf – at this point Rob and Anita Webb presented the very popular option of Disk golf. While some of us had heard of this activity, some had not. Turns out it is extremely popular and courses are popping up everywhere. It was suggested we should put one up at our park. The cost is about \$500 per basket, folks usually have their own disks and a course can run through wooded areas as well as open areas. We will be checking into this in future days and Starla may be writing for some grants if we decide to proceed.

Walk through – David says there isn't a whole lot of seasonal damage. There is some painting that could be done. A couple of benches need to be replaced.

Work Day – our first work day will be Saturday, April 17th at 10. Starla bringing cookies, Cathie bringing hotdogs, etc. Anyone is free to join us.

Other Business –

Reservation application – we reviewed this one more time. We will be adding Starla's name to return checks to either PO box 60 or the drop box at the hall. Otherwise looks good. Starla will be sending written confirmations when the checks are received.

Resignation of Steve and Jill – turns out they have sold their house and are moving to Mount Pleasant! They have done a phenomenal job and we are going to miss them like mad. We wish them the best and will be looking for a new caretaker.

There appeared to be no further business so Doug moved to adjourn, seconded by Starla. Meeting adjourned at 2013.
