

Woodside Park Commission Meeting of 08.03.2021

Meeting delayed 3 minutes but then started without Commissioner Doug with the pledge to the flag. (Doug joined us a few minutes later).

Commissioners present - David Yahr, Darlene Thompson, Starla Jordan, Cathie Kissner and Doug Shoffner

There was quite a bit of public present.

Item #1 was a complaint regarding wording of minutes from Commission meeting of March 2, 2021. There were certain words used in the approved minutes that did not sit well with the speaker from the public. It was also suggested there be a roll call for voting. In previous meetings, unless there was a dissenting vote, all were yays.

Item #2 - There was a bill turned in for reimbursement for David from Harbor Freight for a sander and charger. The receipt given for reimbursement also had a membership to Harbor Freight which entitled to purchaser for discounts. It was felt this was a personal charge and should not be reimbursed for. See notes later.

Item #3 - There was a complaint about weeds along the fencing of the baseball fields and under the bleachers. During our spruce up the park day on 07.31.2021 the bleachers had been moved and mowed under. These weigh a great deal and cannot be moved by a single person.

Item #4 - Disc Golf - there was quite a few people in attendance regarding this subject. We had not heard from the two individuals who claimed willingness to help set this up. The couple who had first presented disc golf to us attended tonight's meeting along with their son, who is an almost professional disc golf player. This young man is very willing and excited to help us build a disc golf course. Further discussion on this subject revealed ways to have individuals pay for holes, signs, etc. and also how the park could benefit from having tournaments on this course. Very exciting and we even had a demonstration!

We reviewed the minutes from previous meeting of 07.06.2021 - Starla moved to accept as presented, seconded by Darlene. Roll Call - David - Yes, Doug - Yes, Darlene - Yes, Starla - Yes, Cathie - Yes. Minutes approved.

We were presented with the treasurer's report - we discussed a bit about it and then Starla made a motion to go ahead and reimburse David for the membership to Harbor Freight, this motion was seconded by Darlene with roll call - Doug - Yes, David - Yes, Darlene - Yes, Starla - Yes, Cathie - Yes. Our caretaker had an issue with a person on 07.29.2021 who sat in his vehicle and stared at both Daniel and his son who was also mowing. It was suggested that next time this happens he get a pic of the person's license plate and call 911.
