

Woodside Park Commission meeting of September 6, 2022.

Meeting called to order at the township hall at 1900 with the pledge to the flag.

Public Comment:

- Deputy clerk was supposed to go over our budget - this did not happen this evening.
- Other comments made were the fact that the restrooms at the park are heavily used. Seems to be they are used 24 hours per day by many people.

New Business -

- Playground safe surfacing - David had a zoom meeting with a company concerning playground surfacing. We have a handout on this company and will be looking into this further probably next spring.
- Benches - the only person who has purchased a bench is Cathie - it is under construction.
- Trunk & Treat - this year Halloween is on a Monday evening and with only 3 commissioners present - we will be having Trunk & Treat on Saturday October 29 from 2 - 4. We will not be serving food this year as event will be in the afternoon. The park will close the Monday after Halloween on November 7, 2022 this year.
- Grants - we have no outstanding grants right now. Now that the ship is here Starla will be submitting a final report tomorrow.
- ARPA- committee representative from the park Cathie Kisser has been in contact with three different contractors to update the parking lot at the park. Anthony Coggins has contacted us. Cathie told him what we are looking to do and he will get back to us with a bid. We are also in contact with Mike from Tri-City Groundbreakers and K. Bradfield. More to follow on this project.

Other Business

- Regarding Pavilion A - someone stacked up tables and used them as shields for a target practice, pellet gun war or some such event - lots of mess to clean up. If anyone sees anything like this going on, please let us know.
- Someone stole soap dispensers from the restrooms - David will have a look at the camera footage.
- Daniel has replaced nuts and bolts on the picnic tables that were in need of such repair.
- We are discussing a regular review of the camera footage to pick up on what is taking place at the park.

Doug made motion to adjourn, seconded by Starla and all were in favor of same. Meeting adjourned at 1933.
