

Woodside Park Commission Meeting of October 4, 2022

Meeting called to order at Hope Township Hall at 1900 with the pledge to the flag

Commissioners present - roll call - Starla, Doug, Cathie and David are here. Darlene joined us by telephone.

There was no public comment

We reviewed last meeting minutes - Motion made by Doug, seconded by David to approve. All were Ayes - minutes approved.

We reviewed the treasurer's report - motion made by Cathie, seconded by David to approve and file - roll call= Starla - Yes, Doug - Yes, Cathie - Yes and David - Yes - report filed.

Old Business:

- **Disc Golf:** We now have the lumber money and three bids - they are as follow:
 - GolfDisco.com - \$8,647.82

 - Innova Disc Golf - \$8,320

Innova is the company recommended by our course designers and as they have the best price for 18 holes, motion was made by David to accept that bid, seconded by Cathie with roll call as follows:

- **Woods:** Complaints regarding the lumbering - some had received unfavorable phone calls regarding this issue. None were present this evening and the contract has been going on for almost two years - proceeding as per contract.

Trunk & Treat: This year is Saturday, October 29 from 2 to 4. No meal will be served this year. We will have David, Doug, Darlene and Cathie present to pass out candy in pavilion B.

New Business

- **Purchase of toys for annual picnic:** Starla watches sales and gets great stuff. While we may keep it to family prizes, we did encourage all commissioners to

pick up float toys, slip and slides, etc. when we see them at ridiculously low prices.

- Grants - there are no current grants in process. Starla has completed the final report to Michigan Baseball (the Loons) for the ship.
- Wish list for next year is a shade sail for the old play-scape
- ARPA- park representative Cathie is currently awaiting bids on upgrading the parking area so that the gate can be moved. Also researching pickle ball and gaga ball. If the township board approves, both the park and the township will be getting new signs. These will go on the existing trailers, just new signs.

Other Business:

- We discussed planting trees in the area of the ship and the two swing sets on the west side of Pavilion A. Cathie will be contacting Maple Hill Nursery and Freeman Nursery for some prices.
- Park will be closing on November 7, 2022.

As there was no other business, Doug made motion to adjourn, seconded by Starla, all in favor said Aye and meeting was adjourned at 1947.
